Aswatna (and the **Nudge Club**) is an attempt to honor that curiosity by providing youth with the tools and skills we believe will allow them to reimagine what their schools and communities could look like.

Timeline

Through ten structured sessions held over the course of an academic year, **Nudge Club** will bring together up to 25 students, counselors, teachers and school administrators to build greater understanding of each other and enable students to share their vision of what an inclusive school environment looks like.



Each session will be led by a student leader who will facilitate activities and group discussions for club members to establish trust and spark conversations about desired change. The sessions would be held during a zero period once a month with the same 25 members starting September.
